Scholarship Eligibility Requirements:

- The applicant must be a high school senior currently enrolled in Gilman, Greenwood, Loyal, Owen-Withee, Thorp, or Stanley-Boyd High School.
- The applicant must be pursuing a career in an educational field; such as, teacher, day care, etc
- The high school applicant must send proof of having completed a first semester and have earned a GPA of 2.5 or higher; and having enrolled in the second semester (with a minimum of 12 credits), in an educational field in an accredited college or tech school before receiving the scholarship money.
- If the applicant is already enrolled in a college/ tech school; the applicant must have completed the first semester and has earned a GPA of 2.5 (or higher); plus proof of enrollment (12 credits minimum) for the second semester in an educational field in a college / tech school.

ESSAY; The applicant must attach an essay (150-300 words) explaining his/her reasons for choosing a career in the educational field. The essay must include influential role models, including former teachers.
