Continuing Education Scholarship Application

Eligibility Requirements

1. An individual who is interested in higher education and is a member or who is the spouse of a member or who has at least one parent, grandparent or great-grandparent or who has an aunt or uncle who is a member or is the survivor of a member in good standing of Eagle Aerie #624 or Auxiliary may apply.
2. Areas of coverage eligibility is limited to those areas in Central Wisconsin covered by Eagles Aerie #624.
3. Student must have a grade point average of at least 2.75. A college transcript of grades must accompany the application.
4. **Students must show, by signed recommendations (at least 2 letters of reference), that he/she has shown service / volunteer work after high school graduation and during college. When listing community service and volunteer work, identify the year and the number of hours involved. Example: Red Cross worker; 2019, 30 hours. Business or College letterhead desired.**
5. Student must plan to attend one of the following accredited institutions during the fall term:
 - a. College or university
 - b. Technical school
 - c. Any other accredited educational program approved by the scholarship committee.
6. Submit a completed application form and typed essay. Essay must detail future plans.
7. You must be obtaining your first undergraduate degree.

Awards

1. The John A. See Scholarship for \$500.
The James DiUlio Scholarship for \$500.
2. Students winning scholarships will receive the scholarship money after successfully completing the first semester of classes. Official grade sheet or transcript is to be presented to the treasurer.
3. You may have earned one scholarship as a high school senior.
You may earn one scholarship as a college student.
A maximum of two scholarships may be earned from Aerie #624
4. If you are not a recipient of one of the scholarships this year, you have an opportunity to apply again during your years in college while earning your first degree. No previous winner of a Continuing Education scholarship may win again, unless a new applicant who is deserving is found.

Deadline

All application forms, grade transcripts, character recommendations (service record) and essay must be submitted by March 1st. Essay must detail future plans. Winners will be notified by mail and will be recognized at awards ceremonies and/or the newspaper.
