Wisconsin Technical Excellence Scholarship (TES)  
Loyal High School**

Loyal High School seniors who are attending technical college after graduation should review the State of Wisconsin’s materials related to the Wisconsin Technical Excellence Scholarship.

Any Loyal High School senior who feels they meet the qualifications for the TES and who wants to be considered for nomination as Loyal’s TES **must prepare a simple resume/list** that includes the following:

1. Student name and contact information
2. Well-organized list of criteria that make the student eligible for the TES. Examples include:
  - a. Chronological list of any CTE courses that the senior has passed (Tech Ed, Business Ed, FACE, Agriculture courses) along with the grade earned in those courses
  - b. Details/years for any Youth Apprenticeship program in which the senior has participated
  - c. Participation in Career and Technical Student Organizations such as FBLA, FFA, FCCLA, including years of participation and offices held

The student resume/list must be submitted to Loyal’s School Counselor no later than the **last day in February** of each school year.

The official **“Student Statement of Eligibility”** (page 2 of this document) must be signed, dated and attached to the student resume.

## CANDIDATE ELIGIBILITY

An eligible candidate for a TES scholarship is a high school senior meeting at least one of the following criteria.

1. Be a CTE Concentrator, which is a high school student who has completed at least three (3) high school CTE courses (career and technical education courses) in program area(s) leading to a degree or diploma in the student's chosen pathway. A student may be enrolled in (rather than have completed) the third course at the time of their nomination for TES.
2. Participated in a Youth Apprenticeship Program under the supervision of the Wisconsin Department of Workforce Development (DWD) (see [https://dwd.wisconsin.gov/youthapprenticeship/program\\_info.htm](https://dwd.wisconsin.gov/youthapprenticeship/program_info.htm))
3. Participated in a Technical High School Diploma program as certified by the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction (DPI) (see [http://cte.dpi.wi.gov/cte\\_tehsd](http://cte.dpi.wi.gov/cte_tehsd))
4. Participated in a Career and Technical Training pathway as defined by the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction (DPI) (see [http://cte.dpi.wi.gov/cte\\_clustersandpaths](http://cte.dpi.wi.gov/cte_clustersandpaths))
5. Participated in a Skills Standards Program offered by the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction (DPI) (see [http://cte.dpi.wi.gov/cte\\_cteskills](http://cte.dpi.wi.gov/cte_cteskills))
6. Completed (or be on track to complete) an industry-recognized certification program approved under Wis. Stats. 115.367 (2). (This requirement is created under 2013 Wisconsin Act 59).
7. Participated in a Career and Technical Student Organization (CTSO) in Wisconsin: DECA, FBLA, FCCLA, FFA, HOSA, or SkillsUSA (see [http://cte.dpi.wi.gov/cte\\_ctso](http://cte.dpi.wi.gov/cte_ctso)) MORE TES Scholarship Program – Request for Consideration October 2014 FINAL
8. Completed a technical training program for high school students if the program is offered by a UW System school, a Wisconsin Technical College System school, a tribal college in Wisconsin, or a private nonprofit college or university located in Wisconsin. Examples include but are not limited to:  
- Medical College of Wisconsin Summer Enrichment Programs - UW-Madison's Summer Science Institute at WIScience - Marquette University's K-12 Engineering Academies - MSOE summer programs for K-12 students
